

Lamps

Trenton's table lighting solutions are made exclusively for lighting purposes. Proper care and maintenance ensure longevity and a professional appearance. Follow these steps to keep your table lighting in peak condition and avoid injury or damage during operation:



1 Clean

- Wipe all metal and plastic surfaces with a soft dry microfibre cloth.

2 Usage Tips

- This lamp may also be used when connected to the charging base.
- It is advised that only the original provided charging base is used. Alternatively, 1A max chargers can be used.
- To preserve the integrity of the battery, we recommend keeping the charging to 20% minimum to 80% maximum; if the lamp is not used regularly it is advised to regularly charge/discharge it.
- Do not charge outside or in wet conditions. Though both Utopia & Lampa solutions are suitable for outdoor use when full assembled, when connected to the charging base, an IP rating of IP20 is achieved, making the product not suitable for outdoor use.
- It must not be exposed to heavy mechanical loads or contamination. Please install and use only after thoroughly checking that it is undamaged.
- Any installation or maintenance must be carried out while the product is turned off.
- Any alterations to the product, tampering with the product, or failure to comply with the instructions may harm the product and make it hazardous.
- Trenton shall not be held liable for any damage caused due to its products being assembled or used in any manner that does not comply with these instructions.

3 Important to know

- The lamps supporting surface should not exceed 15° of tilt or it will fall.
- Your LED Cordless lamp is designed to provide reliable illumination, and on average, you can expect it to maintain 80% of its original battery capacity after approximately 300 full charge cycles.
- Please refer to local laws/guidance for proper disposal/recycling of the battery.

4 Multi-Charge Stations/Stacking Shelves

Cleaning

- Wipe all metal and plastic surfaces with a soft dry microfibre cloth.

Safety

- It is recommended to stack up to 4 shelves maximum. Failure to comply may result in damage of goods and/or personal harm.
- Whenever installing or rearranging shelving, never lift assembled shelving or with units present on the shelf.
